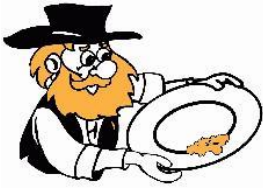


GOLD DISCOVERY DAYS PARADE



95th ANNUAL CELEBRATION

Saturday, July 21 @ 10:00am

Line-up begins at 8:30am

The following is a list of where your section lines up. Only float vehicles will be allowed in the parade staging area, all other vehicles will need to park elsewhere.

DIGNITARY: Ace Hardware parking lot (833 Mt. Rushmore Rd)

FIRST RESPONDERS: Crook St. and 9th facing west in Front of Steele Collision

PATRIOTIC: enter from 5th St. onto Montgomery then down 9th to Crook

HISTORICAL: enter from 5th St. onto Montgomery then down 9th

REUNION: enter from 5th St. onto Harney St

ORGANIZATION: enter from 5th St. onto Harney Street

COMMERCIAL: enter from 5th St. onto Crook St.

RULES TO FOLLOW:

- **PLEASE LEAVE A 2-CAR-LENGTH GAP BETWEEN FLOATS, BUT NO MORE THAN THAT.**

**If your float has walkers, the float must keep up with the pace of the parade-even if the walkers do not. If walkers are under age 18 they must have adult supervision.

- **NO WATER MAY BE LAUNCHED/SPRAYED FROM AN ENTRY!**

- **ANIMALS MUST BE LISTED ON THE ENTRY APPLICATION.** *The staging area for horses is located in the empty lot east of Lynn's Dakotamart. You will then be pulled into the line-up on Mt. Rushmore Rd.*

**If your entry includes animals, you are expected to have a waste detail walking immediately behind your entry with the appropriate shovels and buckets. If you do not have the appropriate clean-up detail, entry in the parade will be denied. Horses must be bagged or followed by "scoopers" during the parade. The staging area shall be left as clean as you found it, or you may be removed from the parade and barred from future participation. You are expected to maintain control of your animal(s) at all times; riders not exhibiting control will be removed from the parade for their own and spectator safety. Animals must have updated vaccinations and health certificates and be able to cope with crowds, noise, and other animals. Animals must be kept on a leash or other restraint. Entrants are not permitted to allow animals any contact with parade spectators. Any entry that uses animals is required to furnish proof of insurance for coverage of a parade or exhibition event.

Return by July 19th at 5pm

Entries received after July 19th can still be in the parade but will not be announced by the parade announcers.
